The Project Background

The rise in youth unemployment levels coupled by various community challenges in health, education, infrastructure, service delivery, corruption, non-inclusive policies, gender inequality among many others in Tanzania, demands great social innovation; for an aggressive drive to solve these challenges through a mechanism that will engage the youth at the center of innovation and solution design, development and delivery.

We believe that this is exactly what social entrepreneurship can foster. Simply put, Social entrepreneurship is a concept that uses business principles, concepts and practices to solve for social problems. Social enterprises focus on triple bottom line approach balancing generating revenue to sustain operations while creating and growing community impact and sustaining favorable environmental practices.

Building Bridges

In light of the stubborn and growing level of youth unemployment in Tanzania and the immense opportunity present in the country for the entrepreneurial sector to flourish, the annual idea's competition, the Tujenge TZ Innovation Challenge (TTIC) was launched in April of 2018 to raise awareness on the potential that social businesses have for individual and national development amongst the youth.

The Tujenge TZ Innovation Challenge (TTIC) is a Social Entrepreneurship Empowerment Program set to build the capacity of growth stage social entrepreneurs and raise the national awareness on the concept of Social Entrepreneurship.

This program aims to increase the chances for youth with great social businesses to flourish extensively in their sectors of social business work and therefore:

- 1. Increase the impact of said Social Enterprises in their communities
- 2. Increase to the rise of the company's socio-economic development agenda
- 3. Create jobs and hence reduce youth unemployment.

The Annual Innovation Challenge features:

- An Idea's Competition: 25 Winners are selected and exposed to expert social entrepreneurship Training, Mentorship, Incubation, and a pool of potential partners and investors.
- 2) An Awareness campaign: A mass social media communication aimed at raising the awareness and dialogue about social entrepreneurship. Simply put, we want mass buy-in.





Who can Apply?

- Applicant must be a Tanzanian Citizen living in Tanzania
- Applicant must be between 18 to 35 years of age
- Applicant must submit a "Social Enterprise" idea that has been in operation for over 1 year.
- Applicant's enterprise must be operating in the Dar Es Salaam Region
- The enterprise must have at least 1 person working on a full-time basis. This may also be the founder and does not necessarily refer to staff
- Applications from all sectors: Industry, trade, health, arts, education, agriculture, technology, Finance e.t.c. are welcome
- The application windows open on the 6th February and closes on the 13th March.

The Tujenge TZ Innovation Challenge is a program that will run in Tanzania for a period of 3 years starting in 2018 and ending in 2020 (which room for further progression).
